#### **BIOGRAPHY**

Aparna Keshaviah is a Bharatanatyam dancer and classically trained musician whose work evolves the traditional lexicon of Bharatanatyam to communicate in non-native contexts. Her modern reformulation of the south Indian dance form has captivated diverse audiences around the U.S., India, and Europe, where she has performed solo and with leading companies like the Ragamala Dance Company. Keshaviah is co-founder of the Dance ARĪS residency in Western North Carolina, a Fulbright scholar in dance, and a Senior Statistician at Mathematica, where she refines research methodology to improve public health.
